



MEMBERS CODE OF CONDUCT

All members shall always demonstrate good sportsmanship, courtesy, consideration and respect towards others.

Be safe.

- All members are required to always wear full equipment, including a helmet and abdominal guard.
- Any member who does not have the proper equipment will not be permitted to participate in the session.
- Members are permitted to take to the outdoor/indoor only when allowed by the coach or the manager on duty.
- **Use appropriate language.** Swearing or the use of abusive language while on the field indoor or outdoor is not appropriate.
- **Respect member's self-esteem.** Encouraging words are welcome. Any member/parent who believes a child's self-esteem or playing ability is being attacked by another member should first speak to their member's coach or the manager on duty, who will in turn discuss the situation with the appropriate parties.
- If an acceptable outcome is not achieved OR the parent/member is uncomfortable discussing the situation with the coach, the parent/member is advised to approach a member of Board of Directors.

Violations of Mississauga Dolphins Cricket Association's Code of Conduct will not be tolerated. If you have concerns, either speak to coach, manager on duty or seek out a member of our Board of Directors. Members/Parents will be contacted if members act contrary to the code of conduct and in severe and/or repeat cases a suspension of membership (short or long term) is possible.
